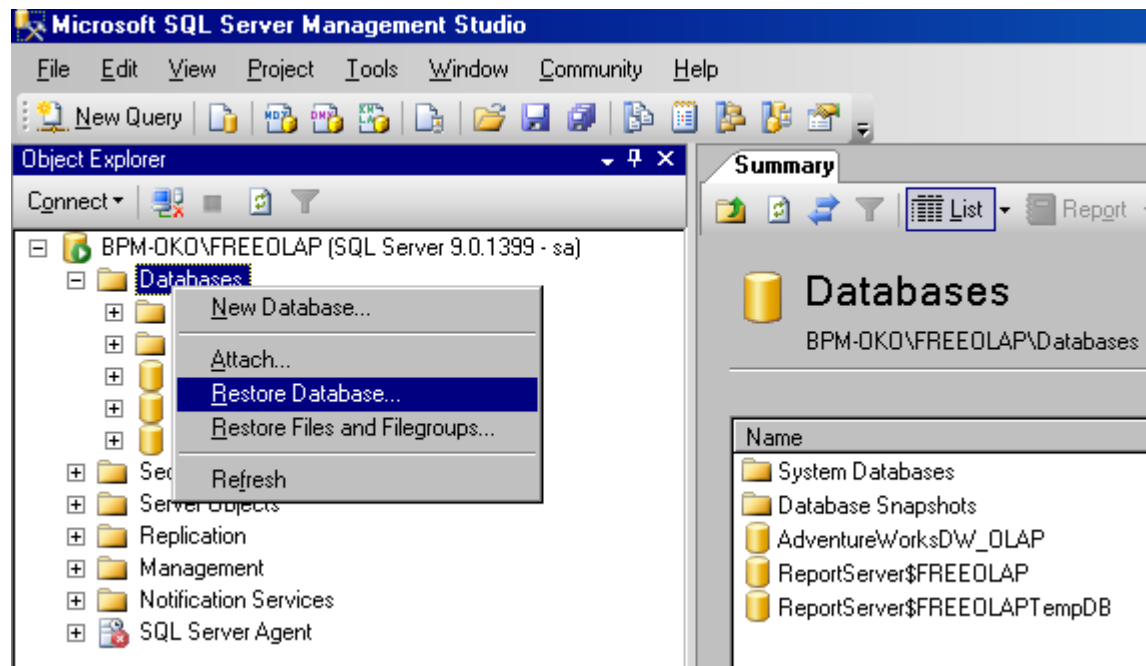

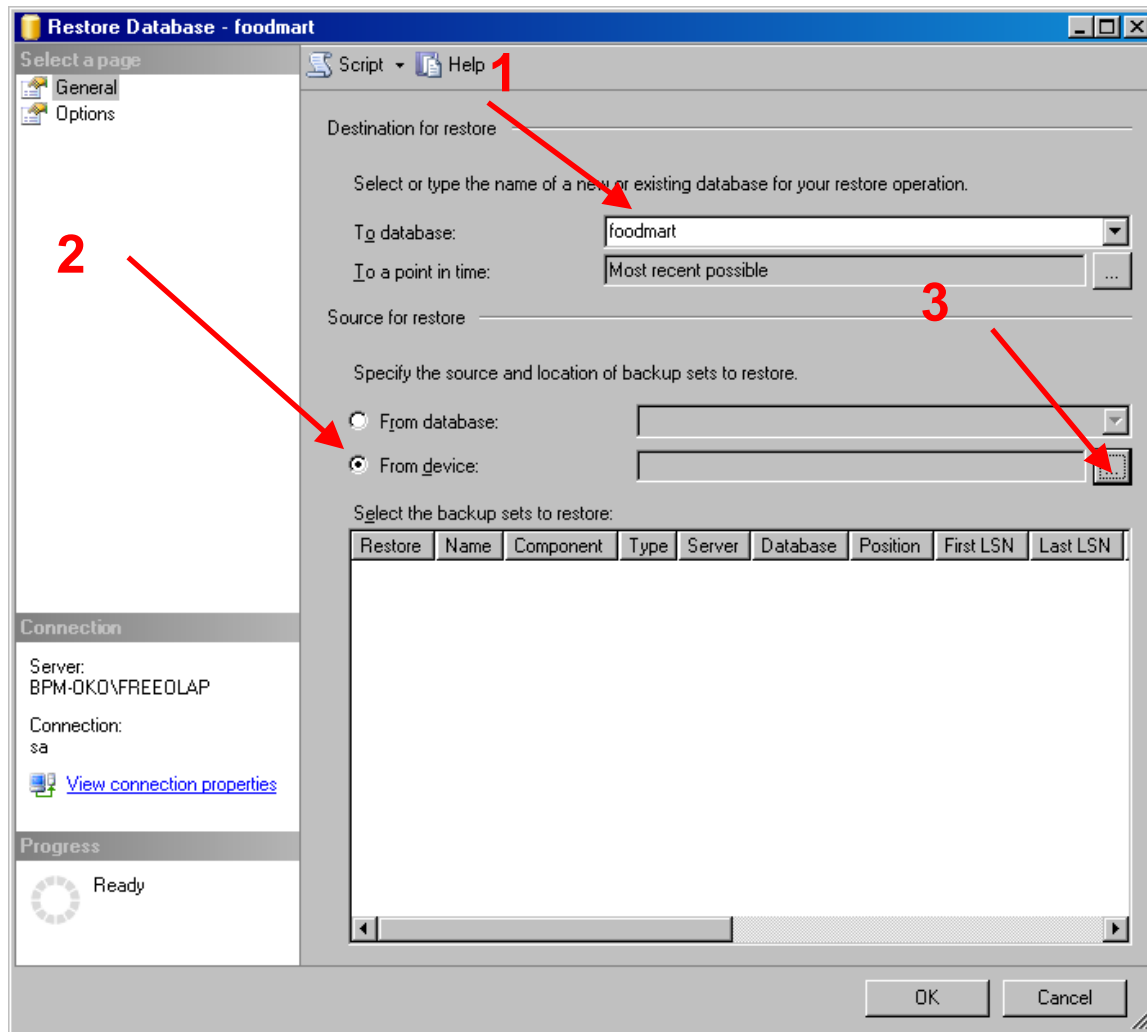

- 1- Download foodmart\_SqlServer2005.zip file
- 2- Unzip this file in your favorite folder
- 3- Connect to your Db admin console – Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio
- 4- Right-click to the Database entry and select “Restore Database”

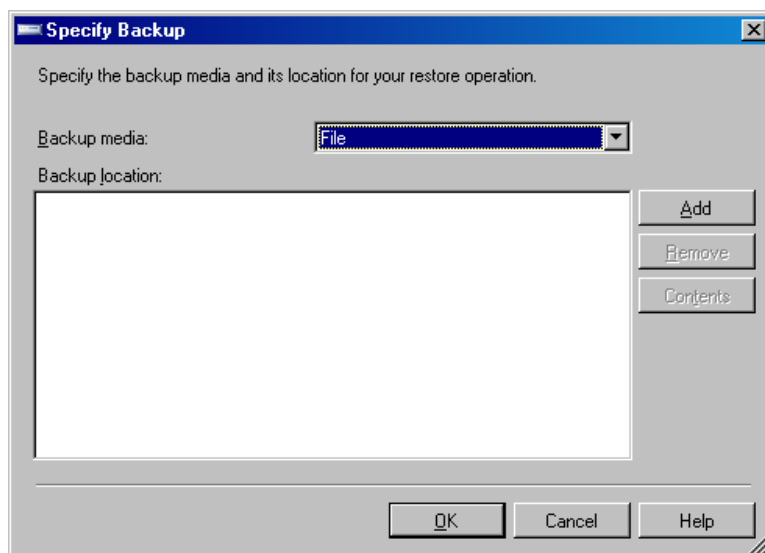


5- In the following window, type the Database name : **foodmart**

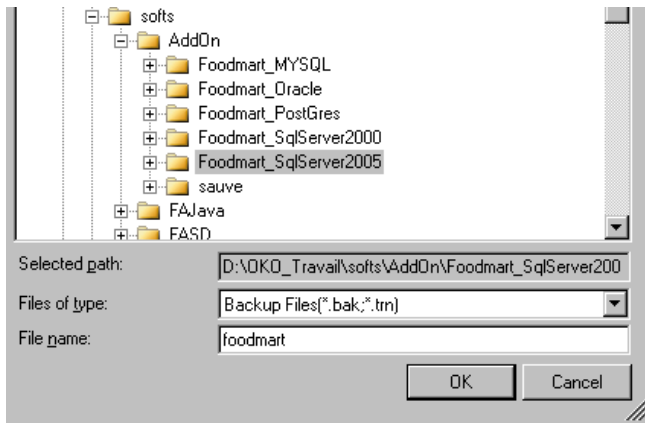


Check "From device" and then click on the button...

6- In the following window, click on the "Add" button

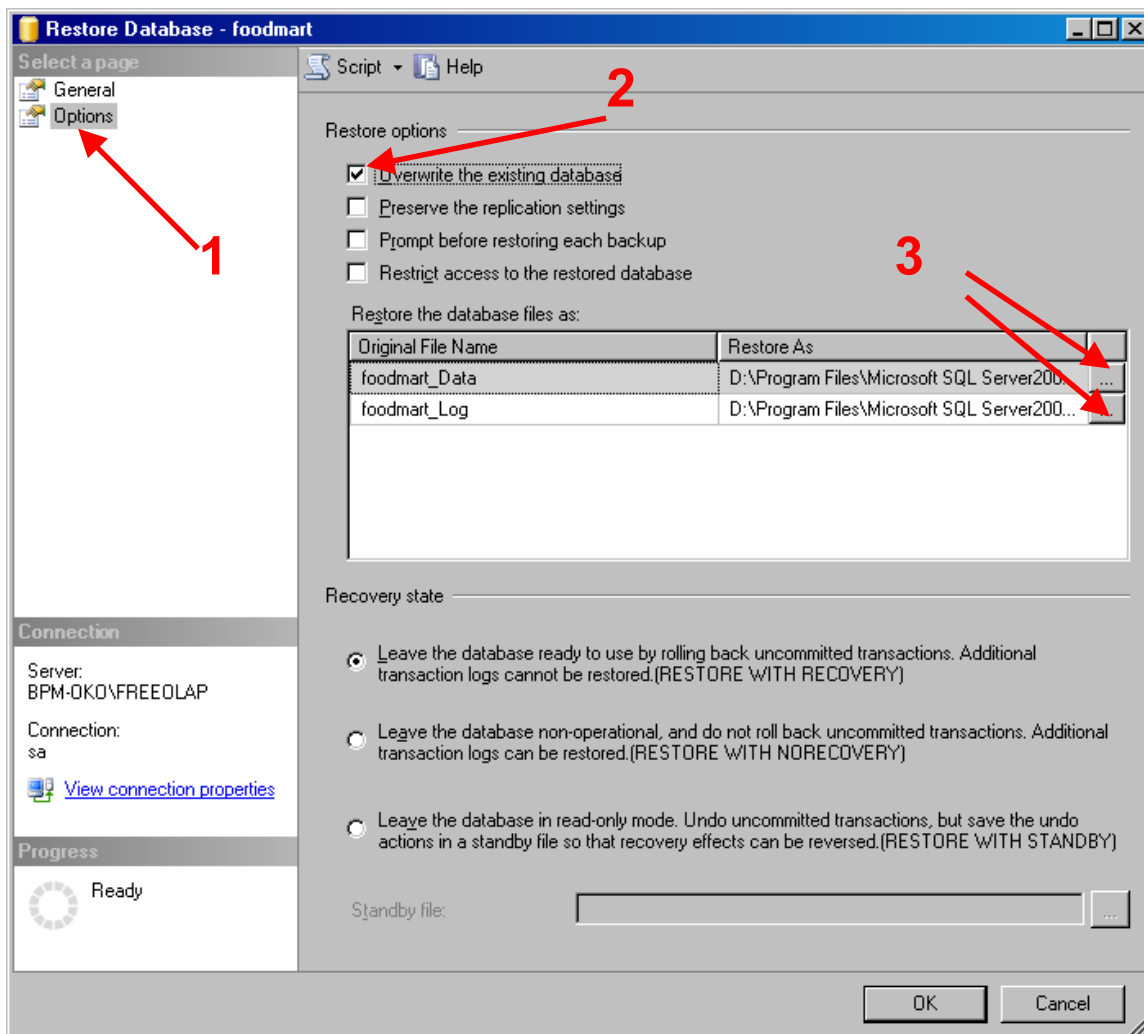


7- In the following window, select your favorite folder where you unzippe your backup and type “**foodmart**” in the File name.



Then press OK twice.

8- In the following window, click on the Options menu and select “Overwrite the existing Database”. You have to modify the path for the Data and Log files.



9- Then, click **OK**.

10- The **foodmart** Database is now restored.
